

# Turkish vocabulary

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Listed alphabetically, here are the Turkish words that I have collected during my reading. Each entry has three sections: (1) the Turkish headword, (2) the meaning in English, and (3) notes.

1. (a) As in the big Redhouse dictionary [1], verbs are given as stems, the sign = replacing the *-mak* or *-mek* of the infinitive. (b) The case of a noun that would accompany a verb headword may be indicated parenthetically. (c) So may be a word derived from (or related to) any headword. (d) Irregular accusatives of noun headwords are indicated non-parenthetically.
2. Meanings are usually abbreviated from what I find in the dictionary (usually the larger [2] or smaller [3] portable Redhouse, or the little Langenscheidt [4]). In at least one case (*gidim gidim*), the headword was not in any Turkish-English dictionary, and so I used Püsküllüoğlu's Turkish-Turkish dictionary [6].
3. Usually the note section is empty. When it is not, it may indicate etymology, with abbreviations

A = Arabic, F = French, P = Persian, YT = *Yeni Türkçে*.

The arrow → of Nişanyan's etymological dictionary [5] may point to a cognate word.

Each headword has a serial number, which, to save space, is not printed with the word; but the range of numbers on each page is given in the footer. Of course words' numbers change as I add new words to the list.
